All funds stay in Saskatoon for vital **HOPE** initiatives including

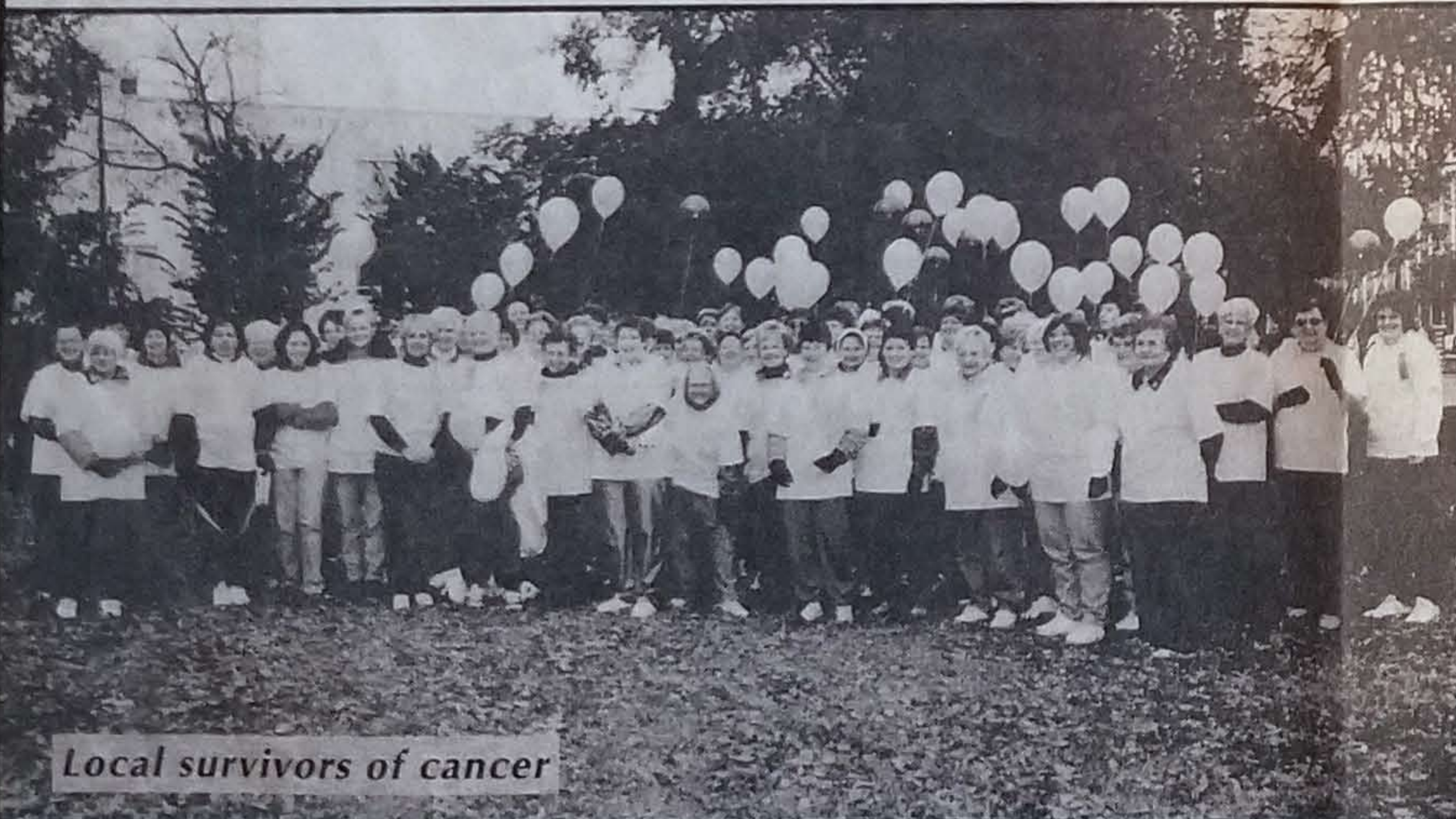
